2007 sees many changes for the club after the agreed joint-venture with Frankston Strikers. This move will bring many positive and exciting opportunities for everyone involved with the club. We will operate two separate Football Departments, namely Seniors and Juniors operating out of McClelland Drive and Delacombe Park respectively. The new proposed entity will be called **Peninsula Strikers Football Club**. In the next coming weeks we will promote a combined competition to find the new logo for the club.

Our Under 12A team has missed super-league by one point last year but the new U13A is ready and already training hard to get a good start of the 2007 season. They have played some friendly matches with positive results such as winning 1 x 0 against Beaumaris who were the U12A winners last year.

Our U14 girls' team has just come back from Ballarat from a 'Girls only Tournament'. They had a great start for the year and after not winning one game last year they were on top of the ladder on Saturday (after 4 matches) finishing 3rd overall on Sunday. Well done.

Over the summer 6 of our players (they were 4 the year before) made the Football Federation Victoria (FFV) Academy Program, which is run from October to March. Another 2 players from the academy have now joined our club.

CLUB BUYS NEW FFV APPROVED PLAYING STRIP MADE BY KELME

As you were all aware, the FFV made a judgement against our playing strip of 2006 (too much black!). The club faced a decision as to whether to have an enforced change of short colour or change the complete strip at some considerable cost. With the massive growth of Junior teams in the FFV leagues and the introduction of a FFV Under 13 team from the Strikers (welcome to players and parents alike), the club has reached the following decision: In order to support the joint venture arrangement with the Frankston Strikers Soccer Club, the club has agreed to provide a uniformed approach to the Senior and Junior teams competing in all FFV competitions. *A new strip has been designed and ordered to comply with the Clubs future direction.* This was deemed to be a more sound financial investment for the long term future of the club. *Kelme* is the newest FFV approved supplier of playing apparel to Australia but has been operating for over 60 years in Europe. There will be a cost associated to all players in FFV competitions (11-18 Years) which will be a short and sock levy. All players will be required to purchase these items in order to participate in these leagues. The club will directly pass on cost price for shorts and socks to all players in these age groups. The club encourages individual teams to seek sponsorship to cover this cost. Sew on company name badges are permitted for all jerseys. Responsible advertising provisions apply (eg Gaming, Tobacco, Liquor, etc will not be accepted). As such, PSC Merchandise will not be re ordered in its current black & white format.
