



General Code of Conduct

All players, coaches, officials, parents, supporters and committee members have a responsibility at all times when representing Peninsula Strikers Junior Football Club to conduct themselves in an appropriate manner, consistent with the code of conduct below.

Club members will;

- Respect the rights, dignity and worth of every person regardless of their gender, ability, cultural background or religion
- Be fair, considerate and honest in all dealings with others
- Never condone rule violations, rough play or the use of prohibitive substances
- Display consistently high standards of positive behaviour and appearance
- Consider the safety and well-being of participants at all times
- Make sure all activities are modified to suit the age, ability and maturity of those taking part
- Promote fair play and participation and not a win at all costs approach
- Hold the appropriate qualifications for your position and provide quality supervision and instruction
- Always respect the officials decision and support them to carry out their role
- Follow all guidelines of FFV and Club
- Respect the policies and practices of FFV and Club (eg. Racial and Religious tolerance, responsible alcohol, etc.)
- Demonstrate a high degree of individual responsibility, especially when dealing with persons under 18 years of age
